  - **Minimum entry number is 3 per class**, for trophy to be contested. Classes will run separately once minimum entry number is reached
  - Classes may be combined at the discretion of race officials, or by unanimous agreement of guardians in the case of junior classes that have not reached minimum entry
  - Format as per P 2.3
- Entry details:**
- Entries will be on the day of racing and will close at the end before Drivers briefing
  - Entry fee is \$60.00 per entry (family cap of \$120 applies)
  - Proof of current membership of a KartSport Dunedin or Southland is required
- Trophies:**
- Lowest overall points accumulated from the day will be 2019 Club Champ in their respective class, provided the class has a minimum of 3 entries; trophy will be un-contested if field is less than 3 entries.
  - There will be keepsake trophies for classes that make minimum numbers
  - Club Champ trophies awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> place-getters, in all grades (providing minimum entry of 3 is met)
- Licence requirement:**
- Open to entries from all holders of current competition licence; 'X'-rated drivers as per rule G1.7.
  - One-day licences will be available at this meeting; grid positions as per rule D2.2
- Transponders:**
- All karts must have a transponder fitted and functioning for tuning runs and racing
